# Charles Mix County Board of Commissioners

# Regular Session - October 17th, 2019

The Charles Mix County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on October 17<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at 10:00 am. Chairman - Neil Von Eschen, opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance and called the meeting to order with Vice Chairman - Nick Stotz and Commissioner – Keith Mushitz present. Auditor - Danielle Rolston, was also present.

# Agenda:

A motion was made by Mushitz and seconded by Stotz to approve the Agenda as presented. All in favor, motion carried.

#### Minutes:

A motion was made by Stotz and seconded by Mushitz to approve the minutes from the October 10<sup>th</sup>, 2019 regular session. All in favor, motion carried.

## Weed:

Josh Rouse – Weed Department Supervisor was present to discuss payroll and the Custodian position for the States Attorney's Office.
