

Charles Mix County
Board of Commissioners
Regular Session – September 15th, 2020
(UNAPPROVED)

The Charles Mix County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on the 15th of September, 2020 at 10:00 am. Vice-Chairman – Nick Stotz opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance and called the meeting to order with Commissioner – Keith Mushitz and Auditor – Danielle Davenport. Chairman – Neil Von Eschen was not present.

Agenda:

A motion was made by Mushitz and seconded by Stotz to approve the agenda as presented. All in favor, motion carried.

Minutes:

A motion was made by Mushitz and seconded by Stotz to approve the minutes from the September 10th, 2020 meeting. All in favor, motion carried.

Bills:

A motion was made by Mushitz and seconded by Stotz to approve the bills for 9/15/2020. All in favor, motion carried.

Highway:

Highway Superintendent – Doug Cimpl was present with the Charles Mix County 5 Year Plan. A motion was made by Mushitz and seconded by Stotz to approve the 5 Year Plan as presented and have Vice-Chairman - Stotz sign the certificate of approval. All in favor, motion carried.

The application closing date has been extended to September 30th for the Highway Department Administrative Assistant position.

Warranty:

Custodian – Randy Winckler was present with Travis Schoby – from Kohler with a Warranty Agreement for the newly placed Kohler Generator in the courthouse. A motion was made by Stotz and seconded by Mushitz to approve and have Vice-Chairman - Stotz sign the \$450 per year agreement. All in favor, motion carried.

Chairman – Von Eschen was present by phone to discuss the Memorandum of Understanding received from the SDSU Extension Program regarding the 4H Advisor position in Charles Mix County.
